## **Virtual Forum**

A Virtual Forum is a collection of <u>Viewpoints</u> on a given topic of contemporary relevance. Virtual Forums are proposed and convened by members of the editorial team, though anyone is welcome to suggest a forum topic. Those contributing to a Virtual Forum are encouraged to address and respond to earlier contributions to that Forum. We especially encourage submissions from early career faculty, non-Global North scholars, and members of underrepresented groups. A Virtual Forum will typically remain open to submissions for 12 to 18 months. Individual submissions will be published in the journal's Setting-the Agenda-section on a rolling basis and will then be linked to a Virtual Forum page on the PG website. The convenor will introduce the Virtual Forum with a short (500- to 1000-word) introduction. The convenor of the Virtual Forum may also invite a discussant to respond to and comment on the entire collection.
